

**DECLARATION APPROVING ELECTRONIC VEHICLE MONETIZATION
AGREEMENT FOR THE FEDERAL HILL AND LEVINSON PARKING GARAGES BY
THE NOBLESVILLE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY**

WHEREAS, the Noblesville Board of Public Works and Safety (“Board”) of the City of Noblesville, Indiana (“City”) has certain rights and responsibilities concerning public parking spaces in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has certain electronic vehicle (“EV”) charging stations installed in public parking areas including within public parking areas in parking garages in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City may install additional EV charging stations in the future in public parking areas; and

WHEREAS, currently those EV charging stations have been made available to the public at no charge; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently responsible to pay the energy bill related to the EV charging stations such that it is not free to operate the stations; and

WHEREAS, Denison, the City’s parking contractor, has indicated that charging for the EV stations is advisable and will help the city recover some of its costs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Noblesville Board of Public Works & Safety of the City of Noblesville, meeting in regular session, hereby declares as follows:

SECTION 1. The Board authorizes the City to monetize the existing and any future EV charging stations.

SECTION 2. The Board authorizes the City to charge a rate that the Mayor or his designee and Denison determine is reasonable. The Board requests that the Mayor or his designee report to the Board on an annual basis as to the amount being charged, the revenues received therefrom, and any issues related to the EV charging stations.

SECTION 3. The EV charging stations may be monetized starting January 1, 2025 and the City may enter into agreements with Denison to accomplish the goal set forth herein.
