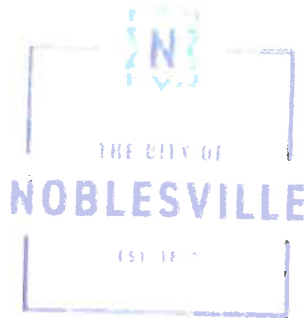

SUBJECT: Change Order for the City Hall Building Management System Project.
DATE: April 30, 2025

The Maintenance Department requests your approval for a change order with Wagner Meinert LLC related to the ongoing Noblesville City Hall Building Management System (BMS) Project.

As you are aware, we are preparing to start the BMS upgrade at City Hall. In April, we began experiencing significant and recurring issues with the Johnson Controls-based BMS at the Public Safety Building (PSB). The system's main controller has been failing to maintain consistent communication and control with facility equipment, jeopardizing operational reliability.

While Johnson Controls has offered a replacement proposal, the cost is considerable and would leave us with an outdated system that is not compatible with the new City Hall BMS.

Wagner Meinert, in partnership with Conserve, has presented a more comprehensive and cost-effective solution. Their proposal involves adding, designing, and integrating the Tridium platform into the City Hall BMS project scope, extending its implementation to the Public Safety Building.

This upgrade will include:

- Installation and integration of the Tridium BMS database at PSB
- Development of a unified graphical interface for both facilities
- Integration of all operational systems into a single platform
- Centralized management of trends, alarms, and operational scheduling
- Configuration of user accounts for both facilities



The benefits of this approach are substantial: a cloud-based management system, reduced disruption to City operations, improved efficiency, and moving toward our long-term goal of a unified BMS across City facilities.

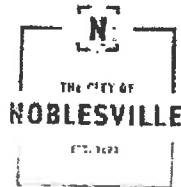
Given the recent issues at the PSB and the strategic advantages of system consolidation, we believe this change order is in the City's best interest.
