Maple Avenue Improvement Project

Maple Avenue will become part of the City's Long-term Control Plan (LTCP) storm sewer project area. Changes are planned for the streetscape (sidewalks, trees, etc.), as well as storm drains, buried pipe infrastructure and the street surface. The overall goal of the LTCP is to improve local water quality in the White River and Wilson's Ditch through reduction or elimination of combine sewer (waste) discharge events during storms.

Schedule:

- Bid Selection Spring 2009
- Construction Beginning August 11, 2009 (moving west to east)
- Construction between 5th and 9th Streets — Summer/late Fall 2009
- Construction between 9th and 17th Streets — through late 2010
- Neighborhood Event Summer 2010



Public Involvement:

- A design advisory committee made up of Maple Ave. residents has been helping the City with design elements of the project to insure the project meets residents' needs.
- A landscape beautification tent event and program is planned for Summer 2010. Homeowners can help improve stormwater on their own properties we look forward to your involvement!
